Description

"Flowerbed in the high mountains". Oil on canvas signed lower left Jacob Alberts (1860-1941). (German School) 231.5 X 141 cm. Jacob Alberts born in Westerhever in Silesia. After training in the field of art in Düsseldorf then in Munich, from 1886 to 1890, he was a student in Paris at the Académie Julian where he followed the instruction of Jules Lefebvre (1836-1912) as well as that of Benjamin Constant (1845-1902). After 1890 he settled in Berlin where he became a professor at the art school for women painters. He participated in the Paris Salon in 1890 with a painting: "Entre Pavots". Oak frame of the time. Accidents and loss of paint at the bottom of the painting at the level of the window of the frame. A small loss of paint of 5 millimeters in the blue of the sky.
