The Coutard fountain, created by René Lalique in 1935, represents the gushing of water droplets with the Woman's Mask motif, designed to decorate the fountain, which is intended as a tribute to women and nature. It reveals the face of a mysterious woman with delicate features, surrounded by aquatic fauna.
