The drawer is mounted dovetail ensuring perfect strength. This is how it can be opened daily and contain many objects. It slide perfectly. The entrances are made of wood in perfect condition. They are very well made. The lock and key are in very good working order. The drawer open with wooden buttons. This organcase rests on feet at cut-off at the front and two straight feet at the back. The back of the sideboard has solid wood panels so very resistant. The top of
