Born April 22, 1820 in Altkirch (Haut-Rhin) Died
in 1898 in Paris.

19th century

French History painter, genre scenes, urban
landscapes, landscapes, watercolorist, painter of
tapestry cartoons, illustrator.

He studied in the studio of Gabriel Guérin in
Strasbourg, then he entered the Ecole des
Beaux-Arts in Paris, in 1844, where he was a
student of Léon Cogniet. He appeared at the Paris
Salon from 1847 to 1880, obtaining a gold medal
in 1878 for the Universal Exhibition.
