Concha BELT Navajo Indians, North America Circa 1900 Silver Length: 101 cm; H: 4 cm

This belt owes its name 'concha' to its shell-shaped buckles. There are fourteen of these slightly domed ovoid elements, with poly-lobed edges and incised decoration of radiating motifs, all joined together with thin rings. Hook fastening. Worn by both men and women.
