He studied in his native village then at the École Supérieure de Valenciennes. showed great versatility from his earliest childhood. A student decorator, then apprentice in earthenware, he drew brilliantly from the age of 13. Painter from the age of 17 he

prepares the drawing professorship and after he will obtain a position at the high school of Valenciennes. Then by chance a vacant position leads him to Honfleur. 1917 His first exhibitions. Illustrious painter and pastellist, he is part of the generation of French artists settled in Honfleur in the 20th century He divides his life between Paris and Honfleur, great lover of pastel, he obtains many honorary distinctions during his first exhibitions in 1917. Decorated Knight of the Legion of Honor in 1923, French and foreign museums and galleries jostle to acquire his works until 1942
