



France 1890-1910, Sterling Silver, Large Tea Service In It's Oak Chest



Description

Very impressive Empire style tea or coffee set in sterling silver. It is still contained in its original oak travelling chest. It consists of a hot water fountain of tea urn with its burner (sometimes wrongly called "samovar"), a tea caddy, a creamer, a sugar bowl, a teapot or coffee pot depending on the use you want to make of it and a small cup intended to be placed under the tap of the hot water fountain. All the pieces are in perfect condition. Each piece is hallmarked, sometimes several times, with a guarantee hallmark for 950% silver with the head of Minerva and a diamond-shaped master goldsmith's hallmark showing the initials LB surrounding a sauceboat. The set of pieces weighs 4200 grams
