



## Empire Period Necklace In Operculum And Silver

### Description

A very old Necklace dating from around 1800 (Empire/Georgian)) set in foiled Silver with Operculum. (Coque de Perles)Operculum is actually found in a marine snail. The shell of the snail has a kind of trapdoor to keep predators out and the snail safe inside. Once the shell is no longer used the "trapdoor " hardens which allows it to be made into jewellery. Each piece is connected by a double chain. The original Cross is suspended from the Necklace. It was quite common that jewellery of this period was set in Silver.
