Charming little "ball" vase, or empty pockets, late 19th century, in enameled glass, Art Nouveau period. In the shape of a purse, its pot-bellied silhouette is slightly tightened by a twisted cord, gold-colored, and knotted, in hot application: a beautiful work of a very seasoned glassblower!..The cord is decorated with 3 floral motif cabochons, 1 in green, and 2 in white. Enameled around the edges with very fine flowering branches, this vase also houses a delicate butterfly within its light decoration...The high, serrated edges are surrounded by a thick green "crest" in application, in the manner of Auguste Jean....Excellent condition, without cracks or chips, some internal scratches, probably due to careless washing...Height = 12.5 cm, diameter = 15 to 15.5 cm Weight = 790
