"Saint-Michel slaying the dragon" by Emmanuel Frémiet, glorious bronze statue from the 19th century dated 1876 (creation of the model in 1875) numbered edition produced by the Charles More foundry in good general condition and having kept its original patina (wear from old age), Frémiet signature on the base. Red griotte marble base included in the indicated height. The sculptor Emmanuel Frémiet was born in Paris in 1824, recognized as a major sculptor of the second half of the 19th century, excelling in subjects concerning historical or religious figures, his fame also owes to his equestrian representations or animal groups. Visible in the highest places, his works are part of the National heritage.
