A silver-plated copper dish is an elegant and functional piece, often used in high-end tableware. The silver brings a shiny and elegant finish to the interior of the dish, making it more attractive for presenting food. Maison Gaillard was founded in 1795 and passed down from father to son until 1992, when it finally closed. Gaillard coppers were renowned for their thickness, robustness and careful finish. They were often used in professional kitchens, particularly in high-end catering. Their robustness and timeless aesthetic make them unique and durable pieces. Pieces stamped with this name
