



## Commemorative Coin Of The Visit Of The Russian Squadron To Toulon, October 13, 1893, Silver



## Description

This medal pays tribute to the Franco-Russian alliance, celebrated during the visit of the Russian Squadron to Toulon in 1893. Obverse: This side features a double portrait in left profile symbolizing the union of Russia and France. In the foreground, the figure of France is depicted in an antique style, wearing a laurel wreath, expressing her majesty. Behind her is the allegorical representation of Russia, with a serene face, wearing an ornamental crown and a pearl necklace. A feminine handshake gesture at the bottom of the medal underlines the fraternal alliance between the two nations. Reverse: It shows a personification of the French Republic, standing facing the sea, raising her arms in welcome. At her feet are a bouquet of flowers and a cannon base, symbols of peace and power.
