Description

This walnut revolving bookcase, dating from 1900, is an exceptional piece stamped by the manufacturer G. Lancelin, domiciled at 24, place des Vosges in Paris. This piece of furniture, with a square section, is a remarkable example of the craftsmanship of the time. The upper part of the bookcase has two shelves, thus offering three distinct storage spaces. These shelves are joined by turned spindle uprights, adding a touch of elegance and sophistication. Below, the piece of furniture offers four semi-barred storage areas, ideal for organizing various objects while adding an interesting visual aspect. The whole is based on an X rotating system, allowing for smooth and practical rotation. This mechanism ends with small metal casters, facilitating the movement of the piece of furniture. This bookcase is not only
