Magnificent and imposing bronze bust of Napoleon I, signed Renzo COLOMBO (R. Colombo) and dated 1885. It is presented with the symbol of the French Empire: an eagle with thunderbolts spreading its wings. Superb brown patina. Edition from the last quarter of the 19th century or the beginning of the 20th century.Marble base.Excellent general condition. Powerful and determined expression of the emperor who we imagine leading a battle. The sculpture presented here for sale is the most luxurious version offered at the time. Indeed, this bust was sold in several sizes -- the largest was, as here, 57 centimeters high. In addition, the imperial eagle was optional. Finally, Renzo Colombo settled in Paris in the early 1880s and exhibited at the Paris Salon in 1883, 1884 and 1885 where he presented his famous bust of Napoleon that was awarded the silver medal at the "Exposition Universelle de Paris" en 1889.
