Serra-Badué favours the use of lithography in his work as a homage to his homeland, as Santiago de Cuba was the first place in the Western Hemisphere to use this printmaking technique. He is quoted as saying 'Through lithography I establish a second visual contact with what I leave behind'. This limited edition lithographic print is titled 'Autoretrato', or 'Self Portrait'. It shows Serra-Badué from behind, focusing on his passion for creating art. Daniel Serra-Badué was a Cuban surrealist artist known for his dreamlike paintings, drawings and prints. Having studied art in various prestigious
