




Photography Bernard Darot The Quai Des Grands-augustins Paris Boats

Description

This photograph by Bernard Darot is glued to a cardboard support. It is signed at the bottom right. The Quai des Grands-Augustins is a quay located along the Seine, in Paris, on the left bank, in the 6th arrondissement, between the Pont Saint-Michel and the Pont Neuf. As for the condition, note the wear of the edges and corners, in particular a corner at the top right which is bent. A brown stain is visible in the middle of the photograph. Bernard Darot, born in Saint-Cloud (Hauts-de-Seine) on October 31, 1934, student of Louis Arretche, admitted to 2nd class on July 10, 1957, honors in project submitted and Prix des Anciens in October 1958, 1st class on December 13, 1960, Second Medal at the Concours Bourgeois et Godeboeuf on December 5, 1961, graduated on June 16, 1965.
