fashionable under Louis XVI, the Directory and the Empire, encouraged the creation and dissemination of works of art with Greco-Roman influence. The craze for engraved gemstone casts (cast on cameos or intaglios) corresponds to the period of the "Grand Tour". During their travels in Italy, passionate collectors and artists brought back in their luggage boxes of cast miniatures as typical souvenirs or as study subjects to be inspired by antique themes.
