A graduate of the Tokyo School of Fine Arts, Yoneji settled in Takaoka, a city renowned for its bronze craftsmanship. He specialized in animal representations, a field in which he excelled, as evidenced by his impressive list of awards throughout his career. In 1920, two of his works were presented to the Emperor of Japan, a rare honor that underscored the exceptional quality of his work. This rooster is distinguished by its elegant proportions and attention to detail, characteristic of Yoneji's style. Each detail, finely crafted as well as a very beautiful patina, reflect a meticulous concern for
