An antique Chinese celadon jar from the Song Dynasty, Zhejiang province. The vessel features a globular form with four loop handles, its green glaze displaying natural craquelure and centuries of patina.

Incised decoration depicts ducks among lotus flowers and leaves - powerful cultural symbols of prosperity and purity. The harmonious form, subtle glaze variegation and incised motifs reflect the refined elegance of Song ceramics.

Measurements: 14 cm height, 15 cm diameter, 696 g.

Condition: looks very good overall, but there is an enamel crack near one of the handles, and two body cracks. One small crack runs along the top rim near a handle and ends where the handle starts. The other is more extended, located on the

side with the floral motif, running about 5 cm down to the top of the flower. Both cracks are very thin and almost invisible against the green background, but they are present.
