Description

Oil painting on canvas, signed lower left by Claude Firmin (1864-1944), an Avignon painter known for his intimate scenes and his talent for depicting moments of everyday life. This work, dated 1892, depicts a woman absorbed in her reading, lit by an oil lamp. Firmin's play of light and vibrant touches give this scene a warm atmosphere. The details of the face, the book and the surrounding objects bear witness to the care taken in this composition.
