o A marabout coffee pot in silver from the french Restoration period. The slightly truncated body rests on its base. The ogee lid bordered by a net is removable, with a terrace in cast silver with channel leaves topped with a seed. The spout is straight ending in a molding; the handle, riveted, is a blackened turned wood.

The illegible second number does not allow us to define one of its possibilities.
