Remarkably comfortable, a skilled upholsterer will be able to reupholster them to your taste without too much expense, because they are healthy and have not undergone successive padding and hammer blows, they are light seats, in cherry (wild cherry), solid, with strong decorative power and assured use by their comfort and robustness; the details of the sculptures show a great carpenter who unfortunately did not stamp his work. The front foot is in plume to receive the dolphin heads, the croce armrest is remarkable in finish and
