A set of five Japanese porcelain blue and white dishes.

Japan, Arita, Edo period, c. 1780-1820.

Dishes on foot rim with scalloped ribbed rim, the well slightly convex and decorated in underglaze blue with a scholar and servant in a garden setting with rocks, florals and houses in the background. A Zen Buddhist text of twenty characters is arranged around the center decoration, this inscription is created using the Sumihajiki (wax resist) technique. Brown edged rim, spur marks to the base.
