In early August 1914, as war loomed over Europe, the President of the French Republic, Raymond Poincaré, delivered a solemn message to the Senate and the Chamber of Deputies. In his address, he called for a sacred union of all French citizens in the face of danger. He declared that France had done nothing to provoke the war but would defend itself with courage and determination if attacked. This speech aimed to unite the nation around the Republic and to justify France's entry into the war as a necessary act of national defense.
