



Crystal Staircase Sideboard From The Late 19th Century



Description

Louis XV style high-height piece of furniture, late 19th century Stamped on the back L'escalier de cristal Paris In marquetry of violet wood, satin-finished arranged in a herringbone pattern and amaranth Chiseled and gilded bronze fittings. Curved on three sides Opening with two curtain doors and revealing two shelves veneered on the edges Moving top surrounded by a gilded bronze ingot mold Oak frame French polish In very good condition *L'Escalier de cristal, created in 1804 by Marie Desarnaud, is located at the Palais Royal, nos. 162 and 163. The shop was taken over around 1847 by Lahoche and Boin, then Lahoche and Pannier in 1857 and finally Pannier Frères from 1890 to 1923 When creating her establishment, Marie Desarnaud had the idea of combining cut crystal with gilded bronze.
