Charming Louis XV period Rocaille planter in chiseled and gilded bronze, scalloped with asymmetrical decoration of acanthus leaves and scrolls, and an openwork shell in its center. A bouquet in gilded bronze and polychrome porcelain flowers, as well as a small figure in Meissen porcelain, elegantly dressed and holding flowers in his hands, decorate the whole. The planter is lined with a removable interior that can receive a floral composition.
