This elegant double-top flying table, dating from 1930, is a superb example of the Napoleon III style. The upper top, in the shape of an hourglass, is inlaid with mahogany and highlighted by a light line of light wood. This top is surrounded by a discontinuous openwork brass gallery, adding a touch of sophistication. The legs, in blackened pear wood, are turned with a constriction and decorated with brass rings, giving the table a refined look. They are connected by a spacer shelf similar to the upper top, but without a gallery. The base ends with small brass sabots, ensuring stability and elegance. This flying table, with its noble materials and careful details, perfectly embodies the luxury and refinement of the Napoleon III style, making it a piece of choice for lovers of antique furniture. ***** Period:
