The upper body opens with a double glass door equipped with an authentic lock, decorated with ribboned brass entrances. The interior houses five shelves mounted on racks, providing modular storage space for your books and precious objects. The lower body, inlaid with rosewood frames on the top, opens with framed doors with joint covers, lock and entrances similar to those at the top. These doors provide access to a shelf also mounted on racks, allowing additional storage. The whole rests on curved feet at the front, adding a touch of sophistication. The cornice, sober and slightly
