Albert Drachkovitch is a French painter born in 1928 in Belgrade, Yugoslavia, he has lived in France since 1939. After studying at the Beaux-Arts and Decorative Arts in Paris, he worked for a restorer. There he discovered tempera painting while working as a restorer of works of art and adopted this method to create works of great finesse in a realism with an inimitable style. Snowy villages,
