Biedermeier period sofa in mahogany with armrests in the shape of a stylized cornucopia and a straight curved backrest.

This elegant sofa has been entirely upholstered in a plant fabric in shades of green, red, blue, beige. It can accommodate at least 3 people. Light wear due to time (see photo).

The Biedermeier style is a style that deeply marked Germany and Austria in the 19th century by perfectly embodying the values of a new art of living. The Biedermeier period corresponds to the "Metternich era" (named after the Chancellor of the Austrian Empire), a period of peace following the Napoleonic Wars, which extended from the Congress of Vienna in 1815 to the revolutions of 1848.
