Techniques of Fabrication: Nando Kallweit is known for his unique method of combining oak wood and bronze. After chainsawing an original piece of oak, the textured details of the surface are transferred to a cavity of clay and sand for casting in bronze. This process gives the works a uniquely organic and tactile appearance, where the grain of the wood and the cut marks remain visible. Artistic Inspiration: The artist draws much of his inspiration from ancient forms,
