The top swivels and folds open to reveal a green baize-lined playing surface, offering both elegance and practicality. The break-front frieze is adorned with shaped scrolled ends, while the edges of the top and the quatrefoil concave-sided base are decorated with intricately carved 'split-reel' moldings. The table is raised on a tapering oblong pedestal with a knulled collar, supported by a quad-form base with hipped, outswept legs terminating in brass castors.
