Naval officer's clock called compendium in gilded bronze dating from the 1900s. Polygonal in shape, it incorporates 4 portholes. In the center, the clock, on the left a mercury thermometer in centigrade, on the right an aneroid barometer and horizontally on the top a compass to keep the course!
