# Description

Oil on canvas measuring 60cm x 73cm plus quality frame 87cm x 101cm representing a place that has now disappeared "The boules court in Sanary sur mer" which was a continuation of the port Provenance: Private collection Laszlo Barta arrived in Paris in the 1920s, joining the Fauve painters in Montmartre and Montparnasse such as Matisse, Dufy from whom he learned the lessons of color placement, Gleizes among others with whom he became friends. Developing an Expressionist style drawing on Fauvism through Cubism and joining Abstraction at the end of his short life, he first studied at the Beaux-Arts in Budapest, active in France since 1926. He exhibited at the Salon d'Automne from 1927 to 1938. He even studied mosaics in Ravenna, which earned him the opportunity to decorate
