The fight with the lioness P. Berjean "Art Deco sculptural group representing a hunter fighting against a ferocious lioness that shows her jaws. The animal is particularly worked with great detail, paying particular attention to capturing the movement, tension and violence of the scene. The representation of wild animals was one of the most frequent themes during the Art Deco period, since it was the time of the discovery of wild Africa, mainly by reporters covering the new gatherings. European society was fascinated by exotic wildlife in the wild, a reflection of a world still unexploited, still far from the control imposed by civilization.
