Born in Nanterre in 1900 and died in Clichy in 1950, he was born in Nanterre and buried in Père-Lachaise.

He developed a passion for painting at the age of 10 and began studying art in the studio of his father Frank Boggs (1856-1923).

Frank-Will is a painter who will immortalize Paris a lot thanks to his brushes. Mainly a watercolourist, Frank-Will spent most of his life in the Montmartre district. The bohemian life of Montmartre no longer held any secrets for the painter!

From 1921, he signed his works "Frank-Will". His watercolours, with a precise and firm touch, are very nuanced, with cloudy skies, were very
