

Condition: very good The Italian design collective "Superstudio" was founded in 1966 in Florence and forged the concept of Radical Design.Its members, Peter Frassinelli, Alessandro Magris, Roberto Magris, Adolfo Natalini, Alessandro Poli and Christiano Toraldo di Francia, realized projects in the fields of architecture and interior design.In 1972, their work was presented at the MOMA in New York in the exhibition "Italy, the New Domestic Landscape". Their collaboration ended in 1978.
