Description

This important gilt bronze Rocaille clock is a superb example of Louis XV style clockwork. The clock features a graceful violin-shaped form and is superbly decorated with fine carvings of accanthus leaves, garlands, foliage scrolls and cascades of flowers, highlighting the highly ornate and elaborate aesthetic of the Rocaille period. Signed on the enamel dial: BAUCHOT à Paris, (rue de Turenne "dictionnaire des horlogers Français" Tardy), this clock is a true masterpiece of craftsmanship and artistry. The gilt bronze adds a touch of opulence, making it a luxurious and striking addition to any antique collection. This Rocaille clock is a timeless piece that captures the elegance and sophistication of the Louis XV period. the plate bears the stamp of: JAPY frères, who received the grand medal of
