These two columns, due to their age and wear,
look like remnants of ancient ruins, and might
even more come across as magnified versions of
the miniature Greco-Roman ruins of Domenico
Padiglione held at Sir John Soane's Museum in
London, or of the Greek temples marble models
of Carlo Albacini held at the Capodimonte.
