Erno NAGY or Ernest DE NAGY

Born in Budapest, Hungary, in 1881. Died in New Jersey in 1952. 20th century. Hungarian-American artist.

Known for his paintings of portraits, landscapes, still lifes, genre scenes, musicians, gardens, carriages, and maritime scenes. He painted many famous portraits over the years, including General "Blackjack" Pershing, whose portrait hangs at the Arlington Air Force Base in Virginia.

He usually worked in oils and painted in a realist style. Ernest's name and dates are often confused with his son's Ladislaus (or Laszlo, or Lazlo) De Nagy (Hungarian, 1906-1944), who was also a
