Huragawara in the shape of a chased butterfly.

Signed silver Kozuka with bamboo motif.

Kogatana inscribed: "Mei-Matuyama Omi
Takahashi Kuni Ju Tsukuru Ou Isseki
chinnoinochi Yshu".

Wari Bashi, signed, in silver, with bamboo stem
motif.

Wooden Tsuka, covered in shagreen and braided
with light-colored silk.

Important silver-plated menukis featuring a finely
chased stork and a full moon.

Openwork iron kojori with a dragon in foaming
water.

Tsuba Shin no maru, in copper, Shoki is engraved
on one side and on the other, two elusive anises.

Mimi (rim) in black.

Fushi, signed, in shakudo-nanako, with
gold-embellished autumn leaves.

Bronze Kashira, featuring Tengu head in relief,
with gold highlights.

Gilded seppa.

Shira saya signed.
