The Port of Le Havre. Paul Alfred Colin. French School of the 19th and 20th Century." Superb late 19th or early 20th century canvas depicting the lively port of Le Havre. The canvas has been cleaned and is in perfect condition. It has not undergone any restoration. It is in its original frame (regilded) with some missing parts.

Possibility of purchase without the frame. The colors are fresh and bright. The work is located at the bottom right, Le Havre and signed on the left Colin. He was a student of Jean Paul Laurens. He is referenced in the well-known Bénézit. He also appears in the little masters of painting by Gérald Schurr and in the dictionary of French landscapers of the 19th century. Nice format, the canvas alone, 63.5 cm x 42 cm. With the frame,
