Description

This rosewood tiered desk, dating from the second half of the 19th century, is a remarkable reflection of the craftsmanship of the period. The apron of the desk conceals a larger drawer, offering a writing desk dressed in a later almond cowhide, which demonstrates the attention paid to detail and functionality. The curved legs of the desk are decorated with bronze falls and sabots, reinforcing the refined and luxurious aesthetic of this piece.
