Artist's stamp on the back Jules Eugène AUCLAIR (1895-1949), tourist and documentary photographer, 95 Rue du Faubourg Saint-Martin, Paris 10th. - Photo format 16 x 21 cm - Under 40x50cm mat Auclair's iconographic production is part of the French collective heritage for having been seen by generations of SNCF travelers, one of his main sponsors. Between 1929 and 1939, he produced a series La France Voyageuse in which he photographed landscapes, churches, monuments with rigorous framing and a sense of detail that is part of the tradition of the French photographic gaze.
