Wood marquetry painting, signed Charles GREYENBUHL (1900-1952) Lovely circular marquetry representing a typical Alsatian village, with its half-timbered houses and its church topped with a characteristic bell tower. The delicate work of the wood species highlights the architectural details and the perspectives of the landscape. Original solid walnut frame, elegantly enhancing the whole. Origin: Alsace, early 20th century Dimensions: 29 cm (excluding frame) Condition: Very good general condition, with a beautiful natural patina. An authentic and decorative piece, testifying to regional know-how and the Alsatian artistic tradition.
