- Six Arras porcelain plates with a border imitating basketwork, with a blue monochrome decoration called a twig, blue line on the edges.
- One Arras porcelain plate with a twig decoration called Mr. de Calonne.
- Two Arras porcelain juice pots with a twig decoration called a blue monochrome and blue line on the edge (old restoration on one handle) see photos.

Plate diameter: 23.5cm - The one called Mr. de

Calonne: 24.5cm Juice pot height: 8.5cm

Each piece marked AR in blue.

The set is in good condition, some minor wear.

de Calonne was created in Arras and is inspired, according to tradition, by the embroidery stick that Mr. de Calonne wore on his jabot: was the motif invented for a service that was offered to him? This decoration is subject to a special price, slightly higher than that called
