Reissue of the silver-gilt campaign service of Emperor Napoleon I, kept at the Carnavalet Museum in Paris. Silver-gilt cup and saucer, engraved, for the first, with the great imperial arms, blackened wooden handle and the number N in a crown of oak and laurel leaves for the second. Minerva hallmarks (1838-current) and goldsmith's hallmark of Claude Doutre Roussel, received master in 1895, some ground.
