Cup and saucer in silver gilt, engraved, for the first, with the great imperial arms, blackened wooden handle and the number N in a crown of oak and laurel leaves for the second. Reissue of the silver gilt campaign service of Emperor Napoleon I, kept at the Carnavalet Museum in Paris. Minerva hallmarks (1838-current) and goldsmith's hallmark of Claude Doutre Roussel, received master in 1895, some ground. Very good condition End of the 19th, beginning of the 20th century weight of cup and saucer: 291g height of cup: 7 cm
