## Description

Emile Thivier. Oil on canvas "Suzanne fishing on the property" Signature stamp lower right E. Thivier. Thivier studio stamp on the back of the canvas. French school. 41 X 33 cm. Emile Louis Thivier was born in Paris in 1858 and died in Lucay-le-Mâle in 1922. He was a student of the academic painter Henri Lehmann (1814-1882) and then took classes at the Académie Julian where the teaching he received encouraged him to favor color over drawing. The painter made his debut at the Salon in 1880 and became a member of the Artistes Français in 1887. In 1896, Emile Thivier acquired a property in Lucay-le-Mâle (Indre), Les Cognées, where he and his family would regularly go on vacation. After the painter's death, part of the funds in his studio were donated by one of his daughters to the Indre
