This pair of vases features a rich and delicately executed decoration, characteristic of the famous Satsuma earthenware, produced in southern Japan. Made of glazed earthenware, the vases are decorated with a vivid polychromy and gold highlights that highlight the figures in relief depicted on their surface. Decoration: Traditional Japanese figures in richly detailed clothing, probably from religious or legendary scenes. The gold halos around the faces emphasize their sacred character. Style: Typical of the productions of the Satsuma Kilns of the Meiji period (late 19th - early 20th century). Shape: Ovoid vases on pedestals with sculpted handles, adding to their elegance. Satsuma vases are highly prized for their meticulous designs, the use of gold highlights, and their decorative value.
